Correction Car Allowance Bradley Kelley

Vice Mayor Adams explained that at the last Commission meeting the amount of \$300.00 car allowance for Bradley Kelley was misquoted. The corrected amount is \$200.00 per month. Vice Mayor Adams moved to approve the \$200.00 amount; Commissioner Holthaus seconded. Roll call: Commissioner Wojcik yes; Commissioner Branch yes; Commissioner Holthaus yes; Vice Mayor Adams yes; Mayor Armstrong no, citing her support for a per mile reimbursement instead.

August and September Meeting Dates

Mayor Armstrong proposed alternative meeting dates for August and September since she has a conflict with her schedule. After some discussion the dates of Wednesday, August 22 and Monday, September 10 for the Commission Meetings were agreed to; the Workshop dates for both months will remain as is.

Parking 176th Ave. West and Lee Avenue

Mayor Armstrong said that an Ordinance was recently passed to restrict parking along 176th Avenue W. and Lee Avenue. After many complaints from residents the Commission agreed to revisit the issue, and listen to constructive comments. A letter from Chief Williams that expressed his version of parking restrictions was discussed.

A lengthy discussion ensued, with time allowed for any resident to express his/her opinion, as well as the Commission to express individual opinions. The general consensus was to consider 3 options: pole to pole diagram offered by Chief Williams; measured distance to corners; and pole to pole on Lee Avenue. Vice Mayor Adams made a motion to have no parking from Gulf Blvd. west bound on 176th Ave. W. to the corner, and no parking on Lee Ave. from the side of the first driveway south to the corner, on both sides of the street. Commissioner Branch seconded. Roll call: Commissioner Wojcik no; Commissioner Holthaus yes; Commissioner Branch yes; Vice Mayor Adams yes; Mayor Armstrong no. Attorney Denhardt will have a revised Resolution prepared for the August 22 meeting.
