FY 2002/2003 MILLAGE AND BUDGET
Wednesday, August 21, 2002, 7:00 p.m.

Present upon Roll Call: Commissioner Dopp, Commissioner O'Connor, Vice Mayor Miller, Commissioner Foerster, and Mayor Beyrouti.

SPECIAL MEETING

Mayor Beyrouti opened this Special Meeting and noted that this is an advertised public hearing to address the Proposed Millage and Ad Valorem Tax and the Tentative Budget for FY 2002/2003. The audience as well as the Commission was invited to participate with the discussion at any time.

Mayor Beyrouti noted that the FY 2002/2003 Proposed Millage Rate and Ad Valorem Tax is 1.6800, which is the same as last year and several years prior.

Mayor Beyrouti reviewed the FY 2002/2003 Tentative Budget in its entirety. Budgetary items e.g. tax revenue, grant funds, stormwater and sidewalk funding were discussed. Mayor Beyrouti noted that a COLA for all employees is included in this budget.

AMEND AND ADOPT FY 2002/2003 TENTATIVE BUDGET

Motion by: Commissioner Foerster to amend and adopt the FY 2002/2003 Tentative Budget as presented.

Second by: Vice Mayor Miller

Roll Call: All yes.

It was noted that some areas will need to be reviewed and clarified for the final hearing on September 9, 2002.

Commissioner Foerster wished to publicly thank the Mayor, Town Clerk, Deputy Clerk, and Finance Committee for their work on this budget.
