MINUTES

Present upon roll call: Commissioner Armstrong, Commissioner Reynolds, Commissioner Holmes and Vice Mayor Lishamer. Absent, Mayor Beyrouiti.

Commissioner Holmes explained that the tentative budget has been discussed at both regular and workshop meetings. The proposed millage rate is 1.6800.

**Amend and Adopt FY 2004/2005 Proposed Millage and Ad Valorem Tax – Mayor Beyrouiti**

Commissioner Holmes moved to adopt the proposed Millage and Ad Valorem Tax for FY 2004/2005 at the rate of 1.68, seconded by Commissioner Armstrong. Roll call: all yes.

**Amend and Adopt FY 2004/2005 Tentative Budget – Mayor Beyrouiti**

Commissioner Holmes asked if anyone had any comments. Vice Mayor Lishamer told the Commission she would of liked to have seen more money in the budget for landscape design for the Town, not just 175<sup>th</sup> Ave. East. Commissioner Armstrong told the Commission she will be working on obtaining grants for landscaping, which can be used anywhere in Town. The Commission discussed creating a Beautification Committee for Town wide beautification. There being no further discussion, Commissioner Holmes moved to adopt FY 2004/2005 Tentative Budget, seconded by Commissioner Reynolds. Roll call: all yes.
