MINUTES

Present upon roll call: Commissioner Armstrong, Commissioner Holmes, Vice Mayor Lishamer and Attorney Denhardt. Absent Mayor Beyrouiti.

Vice Mayor Lishamer announced that Mayor Beyrouiti was not able to attend due to the passing of his father.

Second Reading and Advertised Public Hearing Ordinance 05-12, Approving Undergrounding Utilities Loan

Vice Mayor Lishamer announced this is an Advertised Public Hearing. Attorney Denhardt read Ordinance 05-12 by title. Vice Mayor Lishamer asked if there was any discussion or questions. There being none, Commissioner Holmes moved to approve Ordinance 05-12 on second reading, seconded by Commissioner Armstrong. Roll call: all yes.

Appointment District Two Commissioner

Vice Mayor Lishamer announced two resumes have been submitted. Vice Mayor Lishamer asked the applicants to address the Commission. Applicant Devra Fuller explained to the Commission she moved to Redington Shores seven months ago and owns three properties in Town. Ms. Fuller went on to explain that she is very interested in this Town and the well-being of the Community and would love to be part of the Commission. Commissioner Holmes asked Ms. Fuller if she is not appointed tonight if she intends to run for District Two Commissioner in March. Ms. Fuller told the Commissioners she would consider running for District Two.

Applicant John Branch addressed the Commission stating he has been a resident of Redington Shores for 16-years and has always had an interest in the Town. He has served in other cities as Mayor and Commissioner. He told the Commission he feel he can do a good job and if not he would step down and if all goes right he would like to continue to be a Commissioner and run in the upcoming election.

Commissioner Holmes moved to appoint John Branch as District Two Commissioner to serve out the remaining term until the election date of March 14, 2006, seconded by Commissioner Armstrong. Roll call: all yes. Attorney Denhardt administered the Oath of Office to Commissioner Branch.
